

Prof. Leigh Landy, Professor of Contemporary Music and the Director of the Music, Technology and Innovation Research Centre at De Montfort University, will be Composer in Residence at the SACM from 23 August until 2 September.

Through his wide-ranging research and creative output, Prof. Landy has contributed to developing the field of Music Technology over more than thirty years.
